

Summary of COVID Secure Policy

For group members/ congregation- please read before signing in

- Please do not enter this building without having pre-booked to attend an activity. Please only use the front door to enter and exit (except in an emergency).
- If you are classed as vulnerable or extremely vulnerable you are advised not to enter this building – but it is your choice
- Do not enter this building if you have or suspect you have COVID-19 symptoms, anyone in your household has symptoms or you have been told to self-isolate by NHS Track and Trace.
- If you begin to feel unwell whilst in the building, you and any members of your household must inform the group leader, leave immediately and contact NHS 111.
- You must wear a face covering in the building. Please bring your own if possible; disposable masks and instructions are available otherwise.
- Please keep at least 1m+ away from other people at all times. In an emergency this rule can be ignored.
- Upon entering the building please use hand sanitiser and sign in.
- Do not down the steps or mingle with the livestream or technical team.
- Try to avoid touching surfaces.
- Do not use books and bibles found in the building- please bring your own.
- Only the disabled accessible toilet is in use – please follow instructions located outside carefully.
- Please do not move chairs closer than 1m together.
- Please stay in your seat except to go to the toilet. Do not change your seat for any reason, we need to record an exact seating plan.
- If drinks are served during your group meeting you must remain in your seat
- Please do not sing during the worship time and remain as quiet as possible during livestreaming of services
- If you would like to make a financial donation to the church, but are unable to do so online, please use the offering box by the kitchen door.
- We are not currently running children's activities. Children should be supervised by their parent or guardian, and should be reminded to sanitise their hands when entering and leaving the building and remain sat at the table during services.
- Children under 11 years of age are not required to wear a mask. Children under the age of 3 years must not wear a mask for their own safety.
- Everyone should sign out and use sanitiser when leaving. Please leave in an orderly manner, giving others as much space as possible.
