We believe that:

- 2. The world is facing a severe crisis of climate change and environmental degradation, which has been caused primarily by human activity.

- 4. We repent for and grieve for our part in damaging the planet and commit to change our ways to address this crisis.
- 5. We can act with hope in the face of this crisis. We as, carriers of his Holy Spirit have a role in expanding his kingdom which includes our impact on the natural world. It's our great joy and privilege to co-labour with Jesus Christ to be carriers of his hope to this situation.
