

## Climate and Environment Action Plan 2024

### Ongoing:

1. Inform the church family and visitors about environmental issues through our building displays which we will update at least every two months.
2. Be explicit about creation care being part of our theology and commit to one service a year with a specific creation focus
3. Include a monthly idea for action on the church newsletter
4. Promote other groups and activities that support environmental care such as the Truro repair café, community litter picks and Streetbank
5. We will purchase items which care for both people and planet where the option exists.
6. We will encourage those who are able to walk or cycle to our church site not to use their cars.
7. Trustees to oversee delivery of this action plan as a standing item on their agendas and report back progress regularly to church partners.

### In 2024:

1. Focus a bible reading series on care for the environment
2. Youth to have a focus on environmental issues in teaching programme/activities
3. Re-assess our eco-church survey rating to see if we can improve our rating up from bronze
4. Create a baseline of energy use over at least the last three years and aim to reduce this by 10%.
5. Arrange an Environmental awareness trip or event e.g. trip to Bodmin recycling centre or Forest church

### Longer term:

1. Consider solar panels
