## Adventand Christmas - waiting for Jesus!

Advent is a time of hope and waiting for Jesus. God's people waited thousands of years for his promised Messiah to come. We have the privilege of living in the time after Christmas, Easter and Pentecost – Jesus has already come and sent his Holy Spirit to remain with us. As we read the prophecies about Jesus coming and the familiar stories about the first Christmas, let's use this time to wait and hope in Jesus once more, as we also look forward to the day when he will return.



The bible readings around Advent and Christmas can be so familiar that we can find it hard to get beyond the familiar words and connect with the story and the God of the story. This year as you take time to look at these passages, you might like to try using these suggestions to help you connect with them in a fresh way:



First get yourself comfortable, try and pray in the same place each day, be still and silent and become aware of God being with you (in fact he was here before you even arrived!)



Invite the Holy Spirit to lead you as you read the passage. Then trust him to do this as you read.



**Read**through the passage slowly and attentively.

You might be drawn to a particular word or phrase. Take time to savour and mull over it. Go back and read it again.

In the gospel passages you might want to imagine yourself in the story – maybe as one of the characters or an onlooker. Think about how it would physically and emotionally feel to be in that place at that time. Maybe you want to speak to one of the characters.



**Don'trush**on - spend time with that word or phrase or sense of being in the story.



**TalktoGod** about what is stirring in you. Remember reading the bible is not just about learning about God, it's about having a relationship with Him.



And finally, **don'tworry**if nothing seems to happen – God is still here and is enjoying being with you.
