

"What about you?" Jesus asked, "Who do you say I am?"

At this time, more than ever in history, we are surrounded by other people's words, opinions, ideas, advice etc. With all this available to us at the click of a button it would be easy to find ourselves answering the question that Jesus asked his disciples one day, 'who do people say I am?', the way his disciples did, by telling Jesus what they had heard.

Jesus immediately askswhat was for the disciples a far more important question in that moment -'What about you?' Jesus asks, 'who do you sayl am?' It seems that in this moment Jesus wasn't interested in what others may say about him - he wanted to know what his disciples thought, because that was what would make the difference for them, particularly with the road that lay ahead of them, and the part that they would have in his ongoing mission.

As good and as helpful as other people's opinions about Jesus can be, Jesus wants to know what you think and believe about him - because this is what makesall the difference in our lives. So in the comingweeks, as we journey towards Resurrection Sunday, we are going to follow the life of Jesus through the Gospels, from his birth to his ascension (and beyond). As you read, do so with the question that Jesus asked his disciples that day prayerfully in mind - 'What about you?', Jesus asked 'who do you say I am?'
