Mark's gospel is one of the first accounts of the life of Jesus, with scholars dating his writings approximately 35 to 40 years after Jesus's ascension. Mark, was a co-worker with Paul and a close partner with Peter, he collected eyewitness accounts to give an account of Jesus's words and actions to declare 'The good news about Jesus the Messiah, the son of God' Mark 1 v1

Each Sunday we will read the relevant chapter from Mark's Gospel so by the time we reach Resurrection Sunday we have heard the whole Gospel that declares throughout its pages the incredible Good News of Jesus.

Alongside this, each week there will be a suggested chapter which you can meditate upon for the whole week, you may want to use the following pattern as you come to the passage each day:

- Read the chapter several times
- Reflect on the chapter in light of 'fixing your eyes on Jesus'
- Pray that the Holy Spirit aligns your heart with what is at the heart of the chapter
- Pause and Consider what questions or actions you are to carry through the day
- **Journal** your thoughts, questions and how God is speaking to you
